SPRING 2024 HIGHLIGHTS

PACDC hosted four community programs this past spring: Digital Ambassador, MicroEnterprise Networking, Tech Savvy, and Work Forward. We have provided business acumen to over 85 small businesses and placed 100 percent of our participants on jobs averaging between \$18-\$22 an hour. 100 percent of our Tech Savvy program members learned basic cell phone skills like text messaging, sending pictures and emails.

PROGRAM SUCCESSES

Our **Digital Literacy** program has supported the Akron community in a variety of ways. The Summit County Connect Program, in partnership with the County of Summit, bridged the gap in the digital divide by providing laptops and/or hotspots to Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF) eligible participants in Summit County. We provided 1021 laptops and 927 hotspots across Summit County. The **Tech Savvy** program provides basic technology skills for adults ages 50 and over using Northstar Digital Literacy Curriculum and individualized lessons created by the facilitator. **The Digital Ambassador Program**, also utilizing the same curriculum, provides intermediate and advanced technology users the opportunity to become certified in Microsoft, Google, Social Media, Canva and Artificial Intelligence (AI) applications. As a result of the Tech Savvy and Digital Ambassador programs, 100 percent of our participants are technology sound and confident.

Our **Work Forward** program focuses on an individual's ability to grow their skills and develop the tools they need for business success and ultimately, be placed on a job at the end of the program. The sessions include: interview skills, resume writing, communication skills, how to find a job, how to complete an application, and accountability. They also include sessions from the Ohio Department of Jobs and Family Services- NEXT Program and Financial Literacy from the Financial Empowerment Center sponsored by United Way. As a result of our programming, 100 percent of our participants have not only completed the program, but have been placed on jobs averaging between \$18-\$22 an hour.





Our **MicroEnterprise Network** program has held five cohorts so far. We have served 85 small business participants ranging from start up to 10 plus years in existence. The project objective is to provide small business development training to grow and sustain businesses within the community as a pathway to self-sufficiency. The goals of the project are: Recruit and enroll applicants for the project; implement evidence-based best practices to start, expand and sustain businesses for enrolled participants. The program has provided participants with access to capital -finding to start and sustain a business as well as access to networks to launch and grow a business with guidance and support. From an equity lens, the goals and objectives align and prioritize with the stated concerns and requests of the community and cohorts.

Diantha Freeman was excited to attend the **PACDC Tech Savvy** Program. As an 86 year old West Akron community member, all she wanted was to learn how to use her iPad and stay in contact with her family. However, the **Tech Savvy Program** provided so much more! Mrs. Freeman was so inspired by the Tech Savvy Program, that she retired her old flip phone and upgraded to a new iPhone!! Congratulations Mrs. Freeman on becoming "Tech Savvy!"
